Bolshevik Nominated As a Winner of International Property Awards

Moscow, Russia. October 28, 2016. Bolshevik cultural and office complex nominated as a winner of the prestigious annual International Property Awards 2016. In 2016 the Museum of Russian Impressionism was launched at Bolshevik.
